WHAT IS MOON LANTERN TRAIL?

Moon Lantern Trail is an installation of Moon Lanterns along a self-guided trail located in Pinky Flat.

Along the Trail, audiences can learn about the Mid-Autumn Festival, myths, legends, and celebrations and have the opportunity to get closer to a selection of Moon Lanterns than ever before.

Old favourites, including the 40m long Hong Kong Dragon, will be joined by two new lanterns for this year's event.

Moon Lantern Trail is a one-way walking event. Attendees must keep moving through the area and may not congregate or set up belongings in Pinky Flat.

WHY SHOULD I COME DURING THE DAY?

The Moon Lanterns are colourful and striking to look at during the daytime too!

From midday Saturday and Sunday you can participate in a range of workshops, including calligraphy, lantern making, weaving and more. Workshops are subject to capacity.

Roving performers will be along the Trail during the day and evening on Saturday and Sunday. Circus, lion dancers, puppets and more.

Full program to be released closer to the event.

WILL THERE BE A PARADE?

There is no Parade this year. The lanterns on the Trail are available for viewing throughout the opening hours each day. Each evening, after sunset, the lanterns will be lit.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE?

It will take 30 - 60 minutes to experience the Moon Lantern Trail.

IF THIS IS A FREE EVENT, WHY DO I NEED TO REGISTER?

Moon Lantern Trail has a limited capacity and attendees will not be granted access to the event area if capacity is reached.

Registration is free and is the best way to guarantee your entry at the time you select.

IS FOOD AND DRINK AVAILABLE?

A small selection of food stalls will be at the site selling snacks and drinks. Water stations will be available for refilling water bottles.

WHAT IF IT IS RAINING?

Moon Lantern Trail is an outdoor event and will be open rain or shine. The Trail may be closed due to high winds and other inclement weather.

IS THE EVENT ACCESSIBLE?

The Moon Lantern Trail path crosses flat grassed areas and uses paved pathways. There are no stairs, but the full event path is 425m long. The exit location is 180m from the entrance. Patrons with access requirements are strongly encouraged to pre-register.

IS MOON LANTERN TRAIL COVID SAFE?

Moon Lantern Trail is operating under an approved COVID Management Plan.

Audiences will be required to check-in using the COVID Safe QR Codes or manually sign in prior to entering the event. Audiences will be required to maintain physical distancing, COVID Marshals will be on site.

Face masks are strongly recommended for all persons aged 12 and older.

Persons exhibiting any symptoms of cold or flu will not be permitted entry to site.

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Alcohol and glassware
- Large umbrellas
- Tents or marquees
- Any furniture including folding chairs, bean bags, and cushions
- Sparklers, fireworks or lit candles
- Pets (excluding service animals)
- Barbecues
- Professional recording equipment
- Drones or remote-controlled aircrafts/cars
